3.	Constitution of the Interim Board of Studies for finalising the Syllabus and regulation of B.Tech and Diploma 1 st year syllabus and Regulation as per NEP-2020.	In the light of NEP-2020, the draft syllabus and regulation for B.Tech and Diploma 1 st year has been circulated to the Principal's/ Director's/ HOD's of the affiliated college for their feedback. The same has been received and incorporated. The proposal is placed before the learned member's that the Vice Chancellor may be authorised to constitute an interim BOS consisting of representative from Academia and Industry, which will review the same and make final recommendation.	03(i), 03(ii), 03(iii)
4	Proposal Rectification in the Existing Regulation of MBA	It has been brought to the notice of the University that there is an anomaly at Page no.33 and 34 of the existing regulation of the University. The same is creating doubt amongst the students and hence needs to be addressed. The notified error is with the option of electing FOUR courses from the major area of specialization in the third and fourth semester instead of THREE courses which altogether increases the allotted number of credits from 24 to 28. In the light of above, proposal is placed before the Hon'ble member to allow the major paper to be only three in numbers of such four credit. Further, the marks of extra paper appear in semester 3 may be carry forwarded to semester 4.	04
5.	Conduct of 6th semester Special Examination 2023.	The students who could not appear in the 6 th semester exam due to not promoted status in Semester 4 may be allowed to appear in Diploma 6 th semester exam 2023 for all papers. The matter is placed for the approval of the council.

Because Point No.-17(e) of Page 14 of 39 For each subject, there is passing minimum as follows (iii) Overall, 45% is required for passing (45 out of 100 marks.) has written in the Ordinance. The above proposal is placed for consideration and approval.

2. As per the provision of the Ordinance governing MBA course effective from session 2021-23 and Ordinance governing BBA course effective from session 2022-23, in case the number of students number is greater than 10 the relative grading system will be followed, However for the rest of the course the absolute grading system is being followed by the university. Considering the present structure and need of uniformity in the evaluation of the students across all the courses, the preparation of the results of these courses also the absolute system of grading is being followed, by removing the condition of <10 students in table 18.2 pp.17 of 39 of the Ordinance governing MBA course effective from session 2021-23 and 18 (C) of pp.17 of 36 Ordinance governing BBA course effective from session 2022-23. The proposal is placed for consideration and post facto approval.

10. Conducting B.Arch and BHMCT examination of the students of Awadh College Architecture.

In the session 2020-21 4 students have been registered B.Arch course and 9 students in BHMCT course from Awadh College Architecture and Awadh College of Hotel Management and Catering Technology. However, the Syllabus and ordinance and regulation of Architecture were notified on 18.02.2022. Since these courses were not mentioned in the Academic Calendar of that year hence there examination could not be conducted. Later in the year 2023 when the matter came to the notice of the University authorities, letters was sent to the college for making a representation in person and updates the university about the present status of the registered students. Even after remainder the college failed to update the University about the same, however they forwarded the detail of registered students along with the syllabus of the course. This is surprising that from May 2023, only one student of B.Arch. course is making a follow up for the examination. With reference to the above it is proposed that a three member committee under the chairmanship of
